On motion by Darrell Wiley, seconded by Mark Borrel, to adopt the minutes of the Regular Meeting held on September 13, 2022, printed in the "Weekly News", and mailed to all Jurors. On vote, the motion carried.

On motion by Glenn McKinley, seconded by Darrell Wiley, to accept the minutes of the Tourist Commission Meeting held on September 19, 2022, as presented. On vote, the motion carried.

On motion by Charles Jones, seconded by McKinley Keller, to accept the financial report offered by the Secretary-Treasurer, displaying budget/actual. On vote, the motion carried.

On motion by Bobby Bordelon, seconded by Mark Borrel to add to award waste tire bid to 4 K Farm 7 Trucking. On vote

On motion by Bobby Bordelon, seconded by Charles Jones to award Curry Moreau/Dewey Bernard project to the apparent low bidder Diamond B Construction, \$306,800.00 On vote, the motion carried.

On motion by Glenn McKinley, seconded by Charles Jones to apply for through Capital Outlay for funding to build a Veteran's Service Center. On vote, the motion carried.

On motion by Glenn McKinley, seconded by John Earles, to solicit RFQ's to administer HMGP. On vote the motion carried.

On motion by Charles Jones, seconded by Mark Borrel, to approving the placement of a 7-foot Solomon Northup sculpture on the Courthouse lawn on the Main Street side. On vote the motion carried.

On motion by Glenn McKinley, seconded by Charles Jones to adopt the re-branded logo by the Avoyelles Parish Commission of Tourism. On vote, the motion carried.

On motion by Darrell Wiley, seconded by Glenn McKinley to table Litter. On vote the motion to table carried.

There was a working group meeting held prior to the commence to the Regular Meeting.

On motion by Bobby Bordelon, seconded by Charles Jones to add to the agenda, Cocoville Road speed limit. On vote, the motion carried.

After a public meeting was held, with no objection, a motion offered by Charles Jones was seconded by Bobby Bordelon to reduce speed on Cocoville Road, 350 feet on each side of the Early Childhood Development Center from 45 mph to 25 mph, Monday-Friday from 7 am-8 am & from 2 pm-4pm. On vote, the motion carried.

On motion by John Earles, seconded by Bobby Bordelon, granting authority to the Secretary-Treasurer to pay all bills and waive a reading of the whole. On vote, the motion carried.

There being no further business, on motion by Darrell Wiley, seconded by John Earles, the meeting adjourned at 5:58 p.m.
