2. The PURCHASER agrees to secure all necessary governmental permits and/or all necessary permits from the building owner and/or others whose permission is required for the installation of this sign and he assumes all liability with regard to same and all liability, public and otherwise for damages caused by the sign/awning product or by reason of it being on or attached to the premises. PURCHASER agrees to secure all necessary permission for use of all registered trademarks or copyrights used on the sign.
3. GIBKO SIGNS unconditionally warrants the signs/awning products against defective workmanship and materials for 365 days from date of shipment or installation, if installation is affected by GIBKO SIGNS. 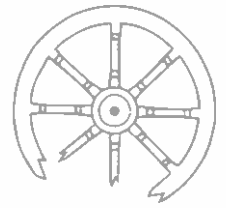



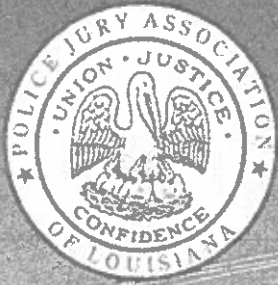

5/21 Sen. Abraham to Chairman Connick in Transportation on Rep. Schamerhorn’s HCR 53

“The distributions for each parish [from the Revenue Sharing Fund of \$90M to offset the homestead exemption] for fiscal year 27 can be found on pages 40 through 43.”

5/21 Chairman McFarland in Senate Finance on HB314.

“It is a simple amendment to add [a representative from] the Police Jury Association on this task force.”

5/12 Rep. Knox at the table in Natural Resources re: HCR 85, a task force on illegal dumping [of trash].

Sent to the Governor Last Week

Code Enforcement & Property Tax Exemption Carrot HB 214 & HB 217 (Henry/Acadia). Set of bills (constitution and statutory amendments) enabling an optional ad valorem exemption option for rehabilitated blighted property. Election November 3, 2026! Effective 1/1/27 if favorable vote.

Public Works Litigation Forum HB 170 (Riser/5 parishes) makes the forum for PW contract litigation the State of Louisiana. Signed 5/15; Effective 8/1

Ethics HB 250 (Turner/Lincoln & Union) narrows financial disclosure obligations for members of boards and commissions. Effective upon signature or 8/1, whichever sooner

Full Property Tax Exemption HB 514 & HB 961 (Farnum/Calcasieu) expands senior property tax exemptions could significantly reduce local revenues, though impacts on schools, law enforcement, and parish governments remain largely unknown. Election 11/3/26; effective 1/1/28 if favorable vote

Waterway Assistance Program Expansion HB 1232 (Bourriaque/Cameron, Vermilion, & Calcasieu) restructures Louisiana’s Waterway Assistance Program. Expands local eligibility, streamlines state review, and shifts to annual applications with preapproved permits required. Sent; unsigned; effective 8/1

Minutes Publication Requirements SB 41 (Allain) increases the # of days to publish minutes from 20 to 31 days after the meeting. Sent; unsigned; effective 8/1

Cybersecurity Locals Reimburse State SB 75 (Hodges/Livingston) GOHSEP must set cybersecurity standards for local governments seeking state assistance, aligning with national norms, while noncompliant entities may still receive help—but must cover associated costs themselves. Emergency rules may guide initial implementation. Signed/Effective 8/1

DPW are 1st Responders SB 164 (McMath/St. Tammany) amends the definition of first responder to include public works employees. Sent; unsigned; effective 8/1

Minor Subdivisions for All SB 172 (Luneau/Rapides) allows all Parishes and Munis to waive hearing for minor subdivisions, versus the current population requirement in excess of 150K. Maintains notice and hearing, and approval requirements. Sent; effective 8/1

Officially Touchable SB 207 (Miguez/Iberia, Lafayette, St. Martin) enacts Code Crim. Proc. art. 571.2 set a ten-year prosecution limit for elected officials or public employees for specific offenses committed during their term/public employees, while other noncapital offenses follow standard time limits, with exceptions for fiduciary, extortion, or juvenile-related crimes. 10-years begins to run when leaves office/employment. Sent; unsigned; effective 8/1

Code Enforcement Enabling SB 334 (Cathey/Bienville, Claiborne, Lincoln, Morehouse, Ouachita, Union, Webster, West Carroll) expands to all parishes code enforcement authority in a bureau of administrative adjudication in RS 13:2575. Sent; unsigned; effective 8/1

This Week in Committee

Local and Municipal Affairs 5/18

HB 481 Riser Caldwell, Catahoula, Franklin, La Salle, and Ouachita) doubles the rate for newspapers. Tempered.

Revenue and Fiscal Affairs 5/19 HB1039

(Deshotel/Avoyelles) updates local sales tax audits, requiring written documentation requests and allowing penalty or interest suspension agreements.

Judiciary B 5/21 HCR

50 Must report how opioid settlement funds in prisons/jails are used.

H Health & Welfare 5/19
SB 4 (Fesi) Fluoridation in water dispute continues.

SAVE THE DATE

Bills To Watch This Final Week

Transportation, Highways and Public Works 5/26

Procurement

SCR 64 SCR64 (Price/ Ascension, Assumption, Iberville, Lafourche, St. James, St. John the Baptist, West Baton Rouge) creates the Task Force on Construction Management at Risk (CMaR) to study the history, viability, and impacts of CMaR public works delivery methods and recommend legislation. Includes the president of the Police Jury Association of Louisiana or designee.

Transportation, Highways and Public Works 5/26

Procurement

SB 513 (Fesi/Lafourche, Terrebonne) amends the Public Bid Law, Enacts RS 38:2211.3 creates a pilot program allowing local governments to award certain public works contracts using an "average bid" method rather than strictly the lowest bid. Up to 15 projects annually may use this approach, subject to legislative (both H&S Transportation) committee approval and post-project reporting on cost, competition, and quality.

Senate and Governmental Affairs (Date uncertain)

Open Meetings Law

HB 1049 Owen, Charles (Owen/Beauregard & Vernon) imposes vague, costly, litigation-prone requirements on local public bodies without evidence of OML failures.

Requires that either legal counsel be present at meetings or that the presiding member has "a general understanding of the provisions of this Chapter." Basically a mandate that everybody needs a lawyer at a public meeting; otherwise invites litigation because the bill assumes training with legal competency. New posting notice requirement. Must give members a draft of minutes in a reasonable time. Significantly increases cost of publication of minutes because would mandate that written minutes include not only the substance of decisions and recorded votes, but also the names of members making and seconding motions.

Senate and Governmental Affairs

Open Meetings Law

HB 615 Johnson, Mike HB615 (Johnson/Rapides) modifies RS 42:23 of the OML to require requires that in parishes with populations over 25,000, all nonelected taxing districts must video livestream their public meetings AND must also have and maintain a website where meeting recordings are archived and publicly accessible for at least two years, creating ongoing administrative, technology, and ADA compliance obligations across numerous small, independently governed parish and municipal districts.

This applies to garbage districts, drainage districts, tourist commissions, road districts, road lighting districts, levee districts, neighborhood improvement/crime prevention and security districts, solid waste disposal districts, fire ant abatement districts, sub-road districts, etc.
