REGULAR SESSION
Tuesday, July 14, 2020

The Police Jury of the Parish of Avoyelles, State of Louisiana, met in Regular Session, in the Meeting Room of the Parish Courthouse, on Tuesday, July 14, 2020, at 5:00 p.m. (CST).

There were present: Charles Jones, Elzie Bryant, Mark Borrel, Glenn McKinley, Kirby Roy, John Earles, Bobby Bordelon, Jacob Coco and McKinley Keller

Also present were: Kevin Bordelon, Civil Works Director; Ron Bordelon, Parish Engineer; Charles Riddle, District Attorney and Jonathan Gaspard, Assistant District Attorney

Absent were: None

The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America followed by McKinley Keller, and opening prayer, led by Charles Jones.

There was no public comment.

On motion by Mark Borrel, seconded by Jacob Coco, the Avoyelles Parish Police Jury does hereby adopt the minutes of a Special Meeting held on June 9, 2020, as printed in the "Weekly News", official Journal of the Parish and mailed to all Jurors. On vote, the motion carried.

On motion by Glenn McKinley, seconded by Mark Borrel to accept the minutes of the Avoyelles Commission of Tourism, held on June 29, 2020, as presented. On vote, the motion carried.

On motion by Glenn McKinley, seconded by Mark Borrel, adopt the minutes of the Avoyelles Commission of Tourism held on June 29, 2020, as presented.

On motion by Charles Jones, seconded by Jacob Coco, the Avoyelles Parish Police Jury does accept the Financial Report as presented during Committee (Budget to Actual included). On vote, the motion carried.

On motion by Elzie Bryant, seconded by Bobby Bordelon, to keep the RDO (regular day off) as is. On vote the motion carried.

A brief discussion ensued regarding COVID 19 Contingency Plan. It was recommended by Juror Charles Jones to table the matter.

On motion by Charles Jones, seconded by McKinley Keller, to adopt a resolution to reimburse the DA \$25,000.00 La CARES Act. If the parish is not reimbursed within 30 days, the District Attorney will refund the money back to the parish. On vote, the motion carried.

Recommendation to table by McKinley Keller "resignation from Solid Waste Committee". No action taken.

On motion by Charles Jones, seconded by Bobby Bordelon, to adopt Resolution No. 1 & Resolution No. 2 rolling forward the adjusted millage rates. On vote, the motion carried.

On motion by Bobby Bordelon, seconded by Charles Jones, to call for a public hearing to install “No Wake Zone” markers on Little River to Bay Sec, markers to be installed by SBRT. On vote, the motion carried.

On motion by Jacob, seconded by Mark Borrel, to accept the Council On Aging project as “Substantially Complete”. On vote the motion carried. On vote, the motion carried.

On motion by Glenn McKinley, seconded by Bobby Bordelon, authorizing advertising soliciting for the Safe Room, 3rd Party Provider required by FEMA, \$23,655.00 match required. On vote, the motion carried.

On motion by Bobby Bordelon, seconded by Jacob Coco, approving Moreau’s Material Yard #473674 \$1,840.83. On vote, the motion carried.

On motion by Jacob Coco, seconded by Bobby Bordelon, to approve Pan American Invoice # 26567 & # 26992, \$8,305.00. On vote the motion carried.

On motion by Jacob Coco, seconded by Bobby Bordelon, to approve laptop and cell for Section 8 Employees (received CARES Act). On vote, the motion carried.

On motion by Jacob Coco, seconded by McKinley Keller, to approve entering into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Town of Simmesport. On vote, the motion carried.

On motion by John Earles, seconded by Mark Borrel, accept Road/Bridge and Off Road Diesel Fuel bids as presented by Civil Works Director. On vote, the motion carried.

On motion by Mark Borrel, seconded by Glenn McKinley, the Avoyelles Parish Police Jury does hereby adopt the procurement policy as presented. On vote, the motion carried.

On motion by Jacob Coco, seconded by Bobby Bordelon, the Avoyelles Parish Police Jury does hereby grant authority to the Secretary-Treasurer to pay all bills and to waive a reading of the whole. Motion carried. There being no further business, on motion by John Earles, seconded by Mark Borrel, the meeting adjourned at 6:05 p.m.
